

PARTICIPATE IN A RESEARCH PROJECT ON LARGE GROUP CONVERSATIONS

Have you ever experienced difficulty following a conversation in a noisy environment? Or do your hearing aids do not help as much as you would like in noisy situations?

Then we need you!

We are looking for participants for two research studies on group conversations:



1. Groups of **eight people**, all of whom have normal hearing.
2. Groups of **eight people**, where at least one — and preferably several — participants are daily hearing aid users.

We prefer that all eight participants know each other, but the most important requirement is that each participant knows at least one of the other participants. In both studies, you will take part in a natural group conversation while we gradually adjust the level of background noise around you.

What is the purpose?

The purpose of this research is to gain a better understanding of how background noise and hearing loss affect conversational dynamics. We also hope that our findings will contribute to the development of even better hearing aid algorithms that can help users communicate more effectively in challenging listening environments.
